


Market Watch Third Quarter 2019

Maize Bran

There were no imports for maize bran for the nine months to September 2019 and in the graph below, the price per metric tonnes does therefore not have any data points. In the same period in 2018, 2,980mt at a value of \$248,706 had been imported.




Maize Bran Imports, 2010 to September 2019




Maize Bran Import Prices (USD/mt), 2010 - 2018

Exports

In the nine months to September 2019, 14,310mt of maize bran was exported at a value of USD 1,311,132 (average price of USD 92/mt). Over the same period in 2018, total exports were 6,743mt at a value of USD 659,370.



Maize Bran Exports (USD/mt), 2018 - September 2019




Maize Bran Export Prices (USD/Mt), 2018 – September 2019


Wheat Bran

In the nine months to September 2019, wheat bran imports amounted to 562mt, a decline of 69% from 1,820mt over the corresponding period in 2018. The total value over the same period is ZWL 90,130 against ZWL 254,585 in 2018.

Foreign currency shortages have been the main driver in the decline of wheat bran imports and the average price to September rose by 14% from USD 140 to 160/mt when compared to the same period in 2018.



Wheat Bran Imports (mt), 2010 – September 2019




Wheat Bran Import Prices (USD/mt), 2015 – September 2019


Exports

Wheat bran exports from January to September 2019 amounted to 4,697mt, a decline of 76% over the corresponding period in 2018. Supply of wheat bran onto the domestic market has been negatively affected as millers exported product to generate much needed foreign currency.

The average weighted price for exports for the nine-month period rose by 55% from USD 76 to 118/mt when compared to 2018.
