- The price of white maize decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$194.69/mt** last week to **US\$178.74/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$180.04/mt**, **US\$171.78/mt** and **US\$150.78/mt** last week to **US\$171.39/mt**, **US\$169.81/mt** and **US\$149.76/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of wheat decreased on the SAFEX from **US\$316.50/mt** last week to **US\$314.57/mt** this week and increased on US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$237.91/mt**, and **US\$201.13/mt** last week to **US\$244.43/mt** and **US\$207.67/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$325.45/mt**, **US\$347.41/mt** and **US\$327.90/mt** last week to **US\$329.60/mt**, **US\$349.89/mt** and **US\$329.66/mt** this week respectively.
- The price of sorghum decreased on SAFEX market from **US\$216.06/mt** last week to **US\$212.91/mt** this week.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from **US77.20/lb** last week to **US76.30/lb** this week.
