## <u>Notes</u>

Prices for both chicken and stockfeeds continue to increase, ranging between 12 and 24%.

However, two feed product lines are below the 8% mark, indicating lower uptake of layer chick starter mash and pullet grower feed (0 - 18 weeks stage). Most table egg producers are raising hens from the PoL stage.

The magnitude of price increases for beef is lower, between 3 and 4% and which may be attributable to a decrease in demand, brought about by declining incomes and buying power and the COVID-19 outbreak and statutory containment measures.

Most stakeholders on the market have indexed prices and a movement in the ZWL/USD exchange rate will result in a shift in prices. Stockholding continues to reduce as sales improve and also as a result of downward adjustment in production as a means of managing shrinking storage capacity.

Day-old Chicks are selling at an average of USD 2 equivalent each and sales have improved.
