TOBACCO

- As at 3 July 2020, 163,757 growers had registered compared to 185,431 who had registered same time last year.
- Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 30 June 2020 stood at 112,497,176 Kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.36/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 116,455,185 kgs sold at an average price of US\$1.81/kg same time last year.
- This realized total revenue amounting to US\$265,4million compared to US\$211.1million achieved same time last year.

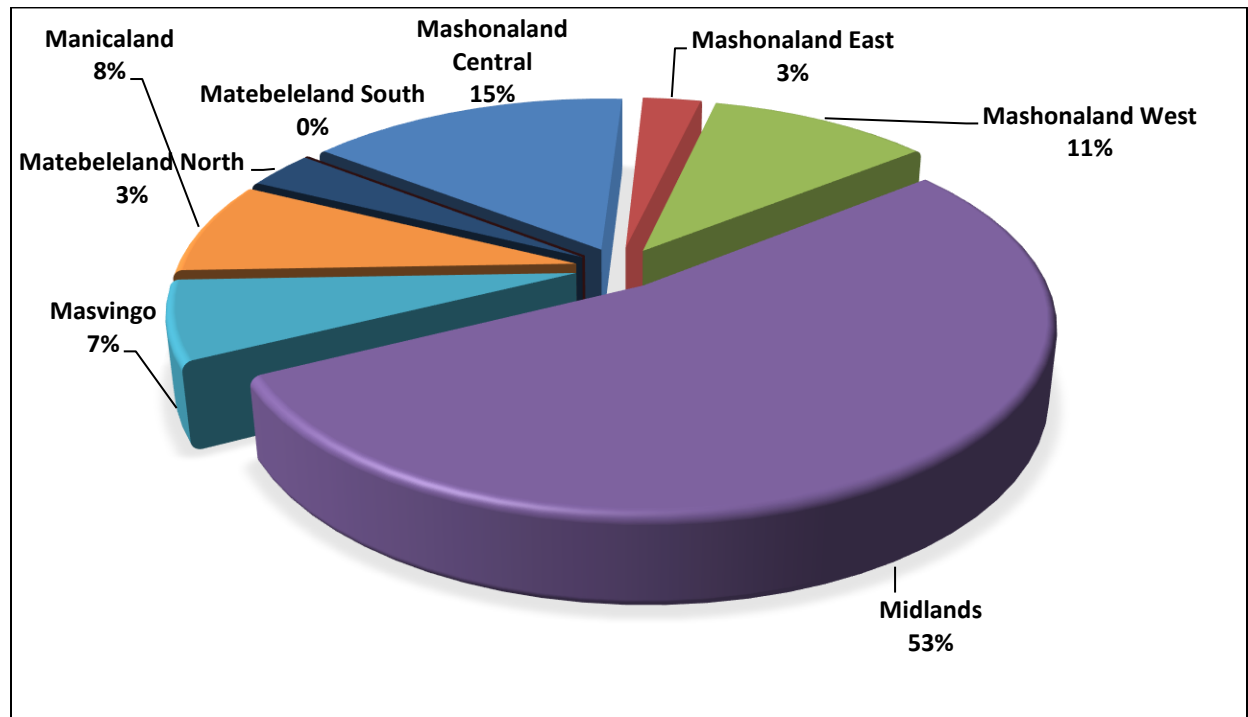

- The price of white maize increased on the SAFEX market from **US\$143.62/mt** last week to **US\$154.23/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$150.14/mt**, **US\$147.06/mt** and **US\$127.63/mt** last week to **US\$161.03/mt**, **US\$158.09/mt** and **US\$137.08/mt** this week, respectively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$299.31/mt**, **US\$192.81/mt** and **US\$176.81/mt** last week to **US\$318.45/mt**, **US\$200.16/mt** and **US\$183.20/mt** this week, respectively.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from **US\$319.63/mt**, **US\$341.99/mt** and **US\$319.89/mt** last week to **US\$330.28/mt**, **US\$351.36/mt** and **US\$328.34/mt** this week, respectively.
- Cotlook 'A' Index increased from **US\$67.95c/lb** last week to **US\$68.85c/lb** this week.
