TOBACCO

- As at 14 July 2020, 165,428 growers had registered compared to 185,592 who had registered same time last year.
- ♣ Total flue cured tobacco seasonal sales as at 14 July 2020 stood at 139,105,885 Kgs sold at an average price of US\$2.42/kg at the three auction floors and contract sales compared to 157,805,161 kgs sold at an average price of US\$1.85/kg same time last year.
- This realized total revenue amounting to US\$336,4million compared to US\$291.9million achieved same time last year.



- The price of white maize decreased on the SAFEX market from **US\$155.72/mt** last week to **US\$149.43/mt** this week.
- The price of yellow maize decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$161.64/mt, US\$158.09/mt and US\$137.08/mt last week to US\$154.77/mt, US\$149.82/mt and US\$133.42/mt this week respetively.
- The price of wheat increased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$334.97/mt, US207.05mt/mt and US190.11/mt last week to US\$337.87/mt, US\$ 222.20/mt and US\$202.31/mt this week respectively.
- The price of soya beans decreased on the SAFEX, US GULF and CBOT markets from US\$331.77/mt, US\$351.72/mt and US\$328.70/mt last week to US\$322.46/mt, US\$348.60/mt and US\$325.62/mt this week respectively.
- Cotlook 'A' Index decreased from US\$69.45c/lb to US\$67.90c/lb.
