Cabbage: Market Trends


Volumes dropped this week by -12.7%, in comparison to the increase of 9.5% seen in the previous week. The overall volume has increased by 6.5% year-on-year, in comparison to last week's 50.9% year-on-year increase. Prices have increased by 3.8% week-on-week, against the decrease of -18.6% seen the previous week.



Carrot: Market Trends


Both volumes and prices in carrots have dropped week-on-week. This week saw a -3.7% decrease in volume, in comparison with the previous week's 12.3% week-on-week increase. The price over the last two weeks has shown a decrease of -5.5% this week and -10.4% the previous week. Volumes year-on-year reflect a decrease of -20.8%, in comparison with the previous week's year-on-year of 16% increase. Price increased 33.9% year-on year, in comparison to the previous week's 35.9% year-on-year increase.



Onion: Market Trends


The quality of the onions has been good, there is sufficient supply and prices remain steady, even though volumes decreased -2.6% week-on-week. Prices have also dropped slightly by -2.7% week-on-week but still show an increase of 8.1% year-on-year.



Potato: Market Trends


Potato volumes have been steady, with no shortages reported. The demand has become strong, even though the prices are high and holding. This week saw an increase of 3.1% in volume, compared with a 0.2% increase the previous week. Price has dropped slightly week-on-week by -2.4%; the previous week also showed a slight decrease in price of -1.3%. The year-on-year price reflects an increase of 45.8%, against the previous week's year-on-year increase of 55%.



Tomato: Market Trends


The quality of tomatoes has improved and is of a good quality. The volume shows an increase of 15.8% week-on-week, in comparison with the previous week's decrease of -16.7%. Price has increased slightly by 3.3% week-on-week, whereas the previous week's price increased by 23.1%. Price year-on-year is high with an increase of 63.7% in comparison to the same week last year.


