Send cash from South Africa to Zimbabwe using Mukuru:

You can now send money from the UK and South Africa to Zimbabwe.. It's an easy process!

From the UK, visit www.mukuru.com to register.

As long as you are over 18 years old and are either a resident or citizen of the United Kingdom or the European Union you can set up your account by registering with us online. Once you have registered on the Mukuru website, you will be able to login with the password you created. Visit https://secure.mukuru.com to access your account.

To place an order, follow the simple prompts on our website https://secure.mukuru.com. You will be asked which country you wish to send to, The receipt method and the amount you wish to send. You will need to have your recipient's details handy (name and cellphone number). Indicate your preferred method of payment, and pay for the order. You will be given an order number via SMS and email which should also be quoted if you have any queries or amendments related to the order.

In addition to the UK and South Africa, you can also send from EU countries as well as from Botswana, Malawi and Zambia.



In order to sender from SA, All you need is a valid ID/Passport/Assylum. The process is the same as that for sending cash from the UK. Alternatively, contact us on 086 001 8555 and we will direct you to a registration point. After registration, place an order by dialling *130*567#, sending a WhatsApp message to 0860018555 and follow the easy prompts or call us on 0860018555.
