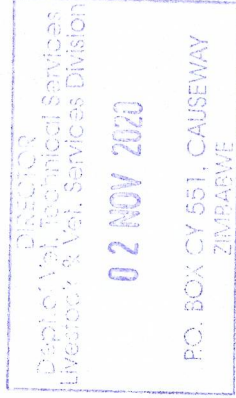

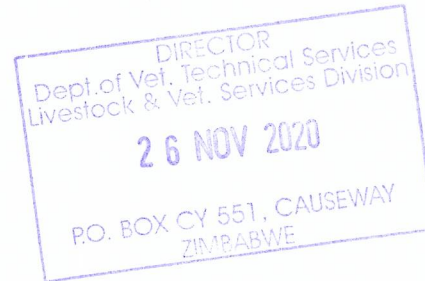



3. VPH and Laboratory import/export inspections, testing, certification and issuance of permits charges.

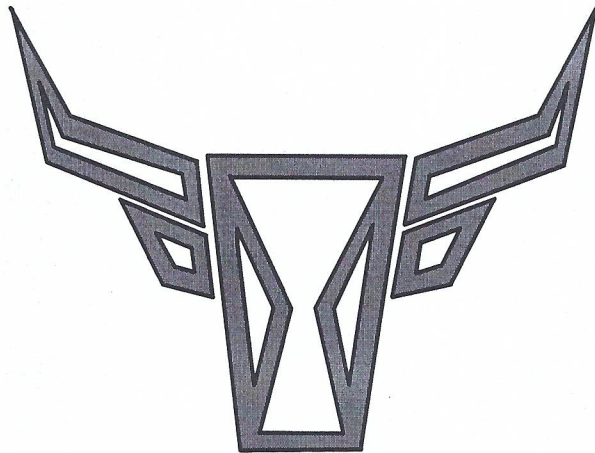
