## Fresh produce market trends Retail and Business Banking

# Good supply, good quality, demand strengthened

Cabbage volumes increased this week to 1916 tons, with the price dropping by 15.5%. Carrot volume and price increased with prices recorded at R3948 per ton. Potato, average price sold for R5 per kg, which have mainly been sourced from the Eastern and Western Free State, but these regions are currently in between seasons which results in less stock and higher prices. Onion volumes were lower with prices trading at around R5 per kg and continue to be sourced from the Western Cape. Market stakeholders at Gauteng markets reported that demand for tomatoes started off slow in the early week and picked up toward the end, selling between R5 to R10 for a 1kg bag, depending on quality. Quality is reported to be excellent on the Johannesburg markets and prices are expected to increase slightly. Supply and quality of all categories considered here are holding firm with demand strong due to month end.


## Cabbage: Market Trends



The price decreased by -15.5% this week, compared to the previous weeks increase of 8.3%. The month on month price this week dropped by -26.6%, against the low decrease of -0.7% the previous week.


## **Carrot: Market Trends**



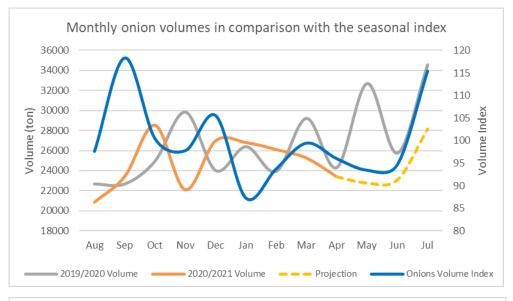
## **Onion: Market Trends**



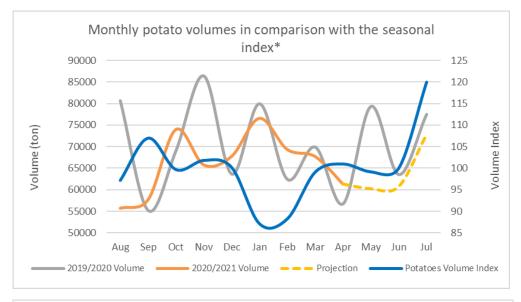
## Potato: Market Trends



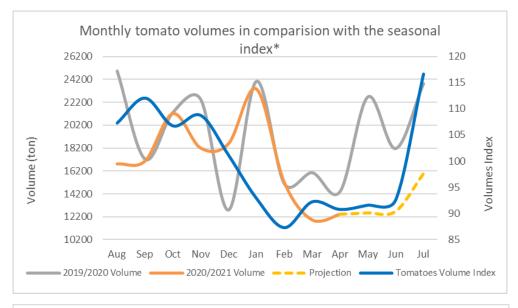
## Tomato: Market Trends


