Fresh produce market trends Retail and Business Banking

Looting hindering fresh produce delivery

Carrots and cabbage sold between R30 and R35 per bag with a firm supply and good quality. Potato and onion demand, in turn, was weaker but being of good quality due to favourable cooler weather. Onions sold for R38 to R40 per 10 kg bag whilst potatoes sold for around R50 per 10 kg bags. Tomatoes sold between R6 to R9 per kg with volumes expected to be high. Quality was excellent, good colour and a nice variety of the produce is available, displaying a good balance between the small and larger tomatoes. Prices may drop due to low sales and store owners may be keeping limited stock to avoid any possible losses. The looting and road closures that are being experienced is holding back some of the transporting trucks from delivering produce. Consumer demand was low and quiet. Some fresh produce markets closed over the weekend and on Monday with concerns around the safety of transport infrastructures continued into the rest of the new week.


Cabbage: Market Trends




Carrot: Market Trends






Onion: Market Trends



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
Potato: Market Trends



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
Tomato: Market Trends


