

Mid-month demand slump creates a drag on prices

Cabbage quality has been good, with prices ranging between R60 to R70 per bag, or R8 to R10 per head. The poorer quality cabbage sold between R20 and R25 per bag. Concern around recent rains and sudden possible heat may impact quality over the coming weeks and raise the risk for pests and insects. Medium size potatoes sold between R30 and R40 per 10 kg bag, but approximately 50% of the potatoes received at the Johannesburg market were of poor quality due to the heat. Good volumes of tomatoes are currently available with market stakeholders at the Northern markets noting quality issues related to over ripening. Tomatoes sold on average for R3 to R6 per 1 kg. Cocktail tomatoes sold for between R45 to R50 per 1 kg with good quality being reported.

Cabbage: Market Trends

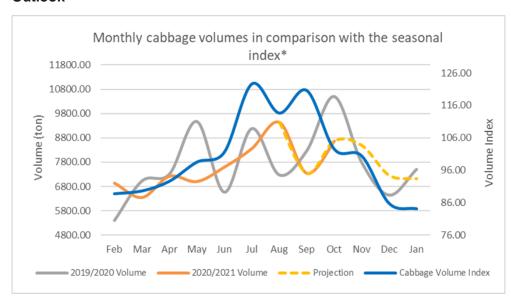
The cabbage volume this week decreased by 16% compared to the previous week increase of 4.6%. This week's month on month volume decreased by a strong 36.8% against the previous weeks decrease of 38.4%. The price this week dropped by 1.8% compared to the previous weeks decrease of 5.4%. This week's month on month price increased by 20.7% in comparison to a very strong increase the previous week of 81.8%.

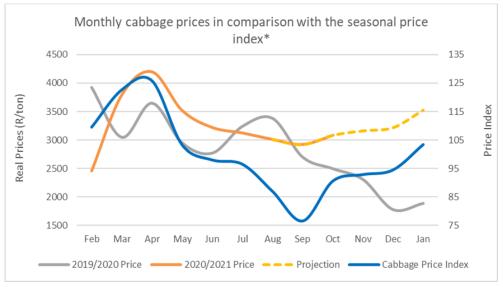

Carrot: Market Trends

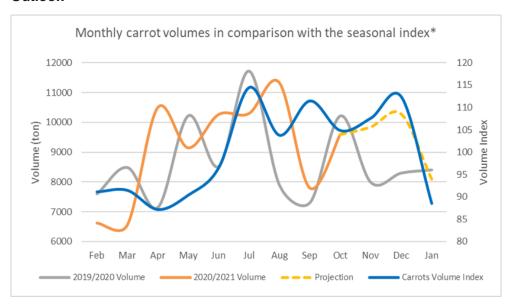

The month-on-month price this week increased by 24.5% compared to the previous weeks increase of 24.7%.

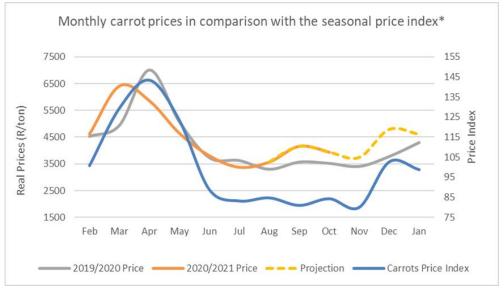

Onion: Market Trends

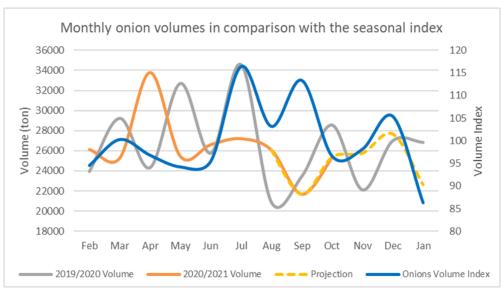

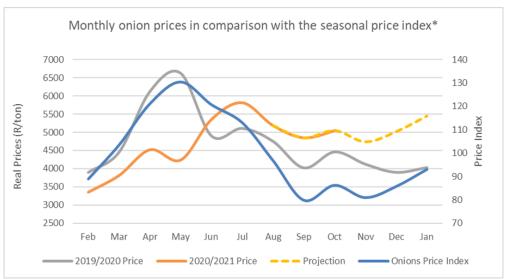

Potato: Market Trends

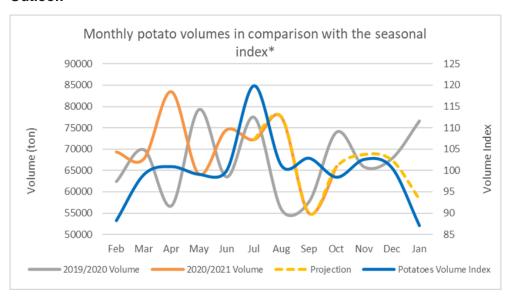

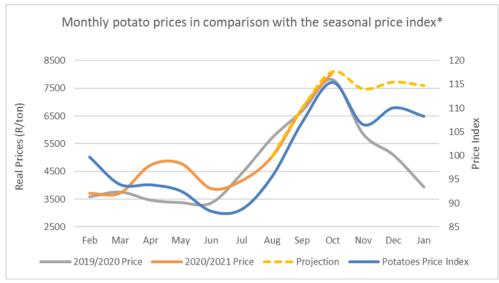

Tomato: Market Trends

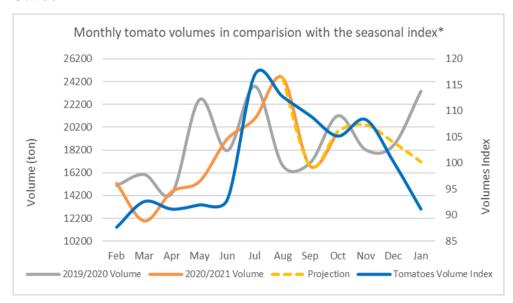

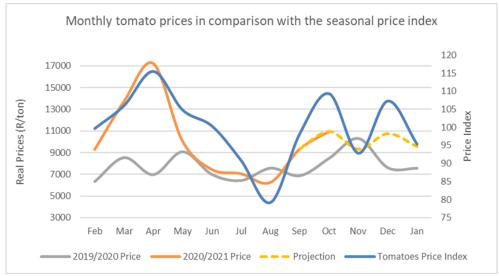
